

DISCLOSURE SCOTLAND

IF YOU CHOOSE TO STUDY AT THE AVIATION ACADEMY YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CLEAR DISCLOSURE SCOTLAND CERTIFICATE.

WHAT IS A DISCLOSURE SCOTLAND?

A Disclosure Scotland is a document containing impartial and confidential criminal history information held by the police and government departments which can be used by employers or others to make safer recruitment decisions.

Disclosure information could include:

- Details of criminal records
- Information about a person's inclusion on children's or adult's lists
- Other relevant information held by a local police force or Government Body
- Or state that there is no information held

WHY DO I NEED A DISCLOSURE SCOTLAND?

A clear Disclosure Scotland is required as your chosen course is studied in a restricted area at Leeds Bradford Airport.

HOW DO I APPLY?

You don't need to apply just yet. Details about how to apply will be available for you in July so that you have your Disclosure Scotland certificate ready for enrolment at the end of August.

Without a Disclosure you will not be allowed to enrol on your chosen course, so it is imperative that you apply as soon as you receive your enrolment letter in July.

Please note that if you apply for a Disclosure Scotland and are unable to enrol on the course for other reasons (e.g. not achieving the required grades) Craven College will not be able to reimburse the cost. The cost of a Disclosure Scotland is £25.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Subsidised Travel*

Travel to and from Craven College can cost as little as £1 per day with our travel bursary. Students with a household income of £31,000 or less can claim a maximum of £200 per term for their main journey. We ask that students use the cheapest form of public transport and make use of any travel passes.

Discretionary Learner Support Fund

This bursary is available to help with up to 50% of the cost of essential kit, equipment and uniform. Assistance from this fund is available to students with a household income of £21,000 (gross) per year or below.

Guaranteed Study Bursary

There is also a Guaranteed Study Bursary of up to £1,200 a year for students who are one of the following:

- In receipt of Income Support or Universal Credit
- In receipt of Employment Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance
- In the care of the Local Authority
- A Care Leaver

Free Meals

You may also be entitled to free College meals through a government scheme. Students will need to complete a College Bursary application form and provide recent evidence of the qualifying benefit*. Once the application has been approved, a credit of £3 per day will be available to spend in the College Café or at a College approved supplier.

Care to Learn

Care to Learn is a government scheme offering childcare support for students who are 19 or under at the start of their course. For further information please visit: www.gov.uk/care-to-learn/how-to-claim

Childcare

For those who are aged 20+ at the start of their course and have a household income of £21,000 or less we can offer childcare support. Childcare costs can only be considered up to a maximum of £125 per week (one child) or £175 per week (more than one child). Childcare must be provided by an Ofsted registered childcare provider.

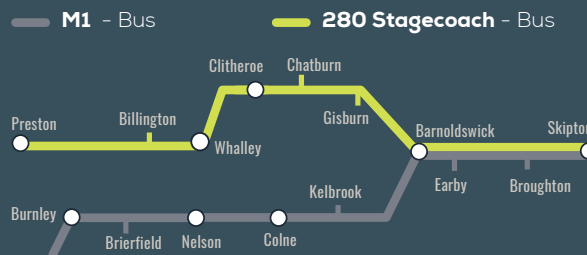

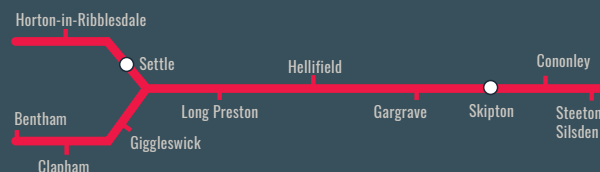

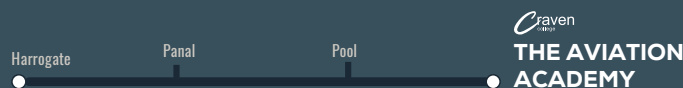
